## MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS MONTH

May is Mental Health Awareness Month and this year, Mental Health America is encouraging everyone to to look at their world and explore how different factors might be affecting their mental health. Do you feel safe? Do you have access to health care and grocery stores? Does your home support you, both physically and mentally?

While many parts of your environment can be out of your control, there are steps you can take to change your space and protect your well-being:

- **Focus on your home:** Keep your space tidy, sleep-friendly and well-ventilated. Surround yourself with items that help you feel calm and positive.
- Create bonds with your neighborhood and community: Get to know the people living around you, join or start neighbors-helping-neighbors groups, and support local businesses to challenge gentrification.
- Connect with nature: Hike in a forest, sit in a city park, bring a plant inside, or keep the shades open to absorb natural light.
